Global Grant Scholarship

Purpose

Support post-baccalaureate study at an accredited international university (outside the U.S.) in one of Rotary International's Areas of Focus.

Scholarship Details

- Amount: Minimum of \$30,000
- Term: 1 to 4 years (must begin in the first year of study)
- Funding Includes: Tuition, airfare, and living expenses
- Funding Sources: Rotary District Designated Funds (DDF) + The Rotary Foundation's World Fund

Eligibility & Requirements

- The applicant must know the university, and program of study, prior to applying.
- University must be located in a country outside the U.S.
- A Rotary Club must be active in the study location to serve as host
- Study program must align with one of Rotary's Areas of Focus

Application Process

1. Complete the official Rotary Global Grant Scholarship application form
2. Participate in an initial interview with the Rotary Club of Austin
3. Finalists are interviewed by the District 5870 Global Grant Committee

- Basic Education and Literacy
